Hand in is on either Wednesday 2^{nd} April, 10am - 12noon, or Tuesday 1^{st} April, 4 - 5.30pm. You may prefer to come a bit later than the start time, to avoid the first rush.

Please follow the requirements on size, framing etc: we really don't want to reject an item which you have put effort into creating, but we also want to achieve a consistent presentation. We will be handling lots of pieces, so labelling as requested is important for the hanging team.

The Private View is on Friday 4^{th} April, 6 - 7pm. We hope you will enjoy meeting other artists and seeing the exhibition for the first time. Please encourage family and friends to come.

Flyers can be picked up at hand in – please do whatever you can to promote the exhibition more widely, and take some flyers to pass on to family, friends and other artists.
